Sister Marilyn Marie Minter has been a member of the Felician Community for 33 years.

Sister Marilyn received her Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education from Felician College. She holds a Masters Degree in Church Music and Liturgy from the Rensselaer Program at St. Joseph College in Indiana, and she is a certified spiritual director since completing a program at the Center of Spirituality and Justice in New York.

After spending a number of years in the field of Education, Sister Marilyn was appointed full-time vocation director for the Lodi Province of the Felician Sisters. Sister Marilyn worked with the Vocation Offices of Newark, Metuchen, Trenton, Camden, Philadelphia, and Wilmington, helping to plan and present programs to foster and nourish the call to use one's gifts and talents in the service of the Lord and the people of God.

In 2003 her Congregation called her to be one of two coordinators of the North American Felician Vocation Center located in Livonia, MI. Sister Marilyn traveled throughout the country working with a team of Felician Sisters conducting Parish Missions and College retreats, and attending youth and young adult gatherings.

Sister Marilyn now serves her religious community as Director of Music and Liturgy at the provincial house in Lodi, as well as being part-time campus minister at Immaculate Conception High School in Lodi, NJ.

She is often invited to speak at various gatherings throughout the country.

According to Sister Marilyn, "the joy of religious life as a Felician Sister is being a living Gospel to all."
